The Driver Alcohol Education Program (DAE) is for individuals charged with a First Offense Driving Under the Influence. MA General Law Chapter 90-24D provides the option of attending a DAE program as an alternative to a lengthier license loss, heavier fines, and potential incarceration. Learn how alcohol and/or drugs may be impacting your life and decision-making.

- 16 weekly group sessions
- Community self-help meetings
- Victim impact forum
