

Recovery is an ongoing process, which can begin at Reflections CAP.

Residential component:

- 90-day stabilization program
- Daily groups that focus on recovery skills and developing healthy lifestyle changes
- Individual counseling & treatment planning
- Wellness activities
- Aftercare planning

Community-based case management component:

- Relapse prevention groups
- Transportation e.g. medical care, individual counseling, self-help groups
- Support with job searches
- Assistance with court communication
- Opioid overdose prevention support
- Family & alumni support
