

What is gambling?

Risking something of value on the outcome of an event when the probability of winning is slim.

What is problem /gambling disorder?

It is characterized by behavior that leads to adverse consequences for a gambler, others, and/or the community.

What constitutes social gambling?

Social gamblers gamble for entertainment, typically do not risk more than they can afford, often gamble with friends, chase losses briefly, gamble for limited periods of time, and are not preoccupied with gambling.

Who provides gambling services?

Clinicians trained in counseling skills and who have received their Massachusetts Problem Gambling Specialist certification.

Payment options
